

## Public License to Use Philip C. Lowe Furniture Designs

### **Background & Summary**

Philip C. Lowe was a furniture maker and educator in Massachusetts. Over the course of a 52-year career, he designed and built hundreds of pieces of furniture and was the owner and director of his own woodworking school, the Furniture Institute of Massachusetts. After Mr. Lowe passed away in January, 2021, his family decided to share his furniture designs with the world. Under this license, you are allowed to make furniture using his designs – if you agree to the terms below. This license allows you to sell the furniture you make using Mr. Lowe’s designs. You can also make changes to and improvements on his designs. However, you are not permitted to sell Mr. Lowe’s designs or new designs you make based on his designs. The license also requires you to write or engrave the phrase, “Design by Philip C. Lowe” on each and every piece of furniture you make using his designs or designs based on his designs.

### **License Agreement**

By exercising the Licensed Rights (defined below), You accept and agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of this license (the “**Public License**”). To the extent this Public License may be interpreted as a contract, You are granted the Licensed Rights in consideration of Your acceptance of these terms and conditions, and the Licensor grants You such rights in consideration of benefits the Licensor receives from making the Licensed Material available under these terms and conditions.

### **Section 1 – Definitions.**

- a. **Adapted Material** means material subject to Copyright and Similar Rights that is derived from or based upon the Licensed Material and in which the Licensed Material is translated, altered, arranged, transformed, or otherwise modified in a manner requiring permission under the Copyright and Similar Rights held by the Licensor.
- b. **Adapter's License** means the license You apply to Your Copyright and Similar Rights in Your contributions to Adapted Material in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Public License.
- c. **Copyright and Similar Rights** means copyright and/or similar rights closely related to copyright including, without limitation, performance, broadcast, sound recording, and Sui Generis Database Rights, without regard to how the rights are labeled or categorized. For purposes of this Public License, the rights specified in Section 2(b)(1)-(2) are not Copyright and Similar Rights.
- d. **Effective Technological Measures** means those measures that, in the absence of proper authority, may not be circumvented under laws fulfilling obligations under Article 11 of the WIPO Copyright Treaty adopted on December 20, 1996, and/or similar international agreements.

- e. **Exceptions and Limitations** means fair use, fair dealing, and/or any other exception or limitation to Copyright and Similar Rights that applies to Your use of the Licensed Material.
- f. **Licensed Material** means the 359 furniture drawings by Philip C. Lowe listed in Schedule A. The Licensor has registered the copyrights to 59 of the 359 furniture drawings constituting the Licensed Material. These 59 works whose copyrights have been registered are listed in Schedule B. For avoidance of doubt, this Public License applies to all of the works listed in Schedule A regardless of whether they are also listed in Schedule B.
- g. **Licensed Rights** means the rights granted to You subject to the terms and conditions of this Public License, which are limited to all Copyright and Similar Rights that apply to Your use of the Licensed Material and that the Licensor has authority to license.
- h. **Licensor** means the individual(s) or entity(ies) granting rights under this Public License.
- i. **Share** means to provide material to the public by any means or process that requires permission under the Licensed Rights, such as reproduction, public display, public performance, distribution, dissemination, communication, or importation, and to make material available to the public including in ways that members of the public may access the material from a place and at a time individually chosen by them.
- j. **Sui Generis Database Rights** means rights other than copyright resulting from Directive 96/9/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 March 1996 on the legal protection of databases, as amended and/or succeeded, as well as other essentially equivalent rights anywhere in the world.
- k. **You** means the individual or entity exercising the Licensed Rights under this Public License. **Your** has a corresponding meaning.

## Section 2 – Scope.

- a. **License grant.**
  - 1. Subject to the terms and conditions of this Public License, the Licensor hereby grants You a worldwide, royalty-free, non-sublicensable, non-exclusive, irrevocable license to exercise the Licensed Rights in the Licensed Material to:
    - A. Access and use Licensed Material; and
    - B. Produce, reproduce, and Share Adapted Material.
  - 2. Exceptions and Limitations. All furniture produced pursuant using the Licensed Material or Adapted Material must include the phrase “Designed by Philip C. Lowe” in legible form engraved or printed somewhere on the finished product. You may not claim ownership of any Licensed Material or Adapted Material or charge anyone for access to or copies of any Licensed Material or Adapted Material.

3. Term. The term of this Public License is specified in Section 6(a).
4. Media and formats; technical modifications allowed. The Licensor authorizes You to exercise the Licensed Rights in all media and formats whether now known or hereafter created, and to make technical modifications necessary to do so. The Licensor waives and/or agrees not to assert any right or authority to forbid You from making technical modifications necessary to exercise the Licensed Rights, including technical modifications necessary to circumvent Effective Technological Measures. For purposes of this Public License, simply making modifications authorized by this Section 2(a)(4) never produces Adapted Material.
5. Downstream recipients.
  - A. Offer from the Licensor – Licensed Material. Every recipient of the Licensed Material automatically receives an offer from the Licensor to exercise the Licensed Rights under the terms and conditions of this Public License.
  - B. Additional offer from the Licensor – Adapted Material. Every recipient of Adapted Material from You automatically receives an offer from the Licensor to exercise the Licensed Rights in the Adapted Material under the conditions of the Adapter’s License You apply.
  - C. No downstream restrictions. You may not offer or impose any additional or different terms or conditions on, or apply any Effective Technological Measures to, the Licensed Material if doing so restricts exercise of the Licensed Rights by any recipient of the Licensed Material.
6. No endorsement. Nothing in this Public License constitutes or may be construed as permission to assert or imply that You are, or that Your use of the Licensed Material is, connected with, or sponsored, endorsed, or granted official status by, the Licensor or others designated to receive attribution as provided in Section 3(a)(1).

**b. Other rights.**

1. Moral rights, such as the right of integrity, are not licensed under this Public License, nor are publicity, privacy, and/or other similar personality rights; however, to the extent possible, the Licensor waives and/or agrees not to assert any such rights held by the Licensor to the limited extent necessary to allow You to exercise the Licensed Rights, but not otherwise.
2. Patent and trademark rights are not licensed under this Public License.
3. To the extent possible, the Licensor waives any right to collect royalties from You for the exercise of the Licensed Rights, whether directly or through a collecting society under any voluntary or waivable statutory or compulsory licensing

scheme. In all other cases the Licensor expressly reserves any right to collect such royalties.

### **Section 3 – License Conditions.**

Your exercise of the Licensed Rights is expressly made subject to the following conditions.

a. **Attribution.**

1. If You make anything using the Licensed Material or Adapted Material, you must include the phrase “Designed by Philip C. Lowe” in legible form engraved or printed somewhere on the finished product. For avoidance of doubt, this includes furniture, 3-D models, pictures, and anything else that you would not be permitted to make without the Licensed Rights.

### **Section 4 – Sui Generis Database Rights.**

Where the Licensed Rights include Sui Generis Database Rights that apply to Your use of the Licensed Material:

- a. for the avoidance of doubt, Section 2(a)(1) grants You the right to extract, reuse, reproduce, and Share all or a substantial portion of the contents of the database;
- b. if You include all or a substantial portion of the database contents in a database in which You have Sui Generis Database Rights, then the database in which You have Sui Generis Database Rights (but not its individual contents) is Adapted Material; and
- c. You must comply with the conditions in Section 3(a) if You Share all or a substantial portion of the contents of the database.

For the avoidance of doubt, this Section 4 supplements and does not replace Your obligations under this Public License where the Licensed Rights include other Copyright and Similar Rights.

### **Section 5 – Disclaimer of Warranties and Limitation of Liability.**

- a. **Unless otherwise separately undertaken by the Licensor, to the extent possible, the Licensor offers the Licensed Material as-is and as-available, and makes no representations or warranties of any kind concerning the Licensed Material, whether express, implied, statutory, or other. This includes, without limitation, warranties of title, merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, non-infringement, absence of latent or other defects, accuracy, or the presence or absence of errors, whether or not known or discoverable. Where disclaimers of warranties are not allowed in full or in part, this disclaimer may not apply to You.**
- b. **To the extent possible, in no event will the Licensor be liable to You on any legal theory (including, without limitation, negligence) or otherwise for any direct, special, indirect, incidental, consequential, punitive, exemplary, or other losses, costs, expenses, or damages arising out of this Public License or use of the Licensed Material, even if the Licensor has been advised of the possibility of such losses, costs,**

**expenses, or damages. Where a limitation of liability is not allowed in full or in part, this limitation may not apply to You.**

- c. The disclaimer of warranties and limitation of liability provided above shall be interpreted in a manner that, to the extent possible, most closely approximates an absolute disclaimer and waiver of all liability.

#### **Section 6 – Term and Termination.**

- a. This Public License applies for the term of the Copyright and Similar Rights licensed here. However, if You fail to comply with this Public License, then Your rights under this Public License terminate automatically.
- b. Where Your right to use the Licensed Material has terminated under Section 6(a), it reinstates:
  - 1. automatically as of the date the violation is cured, provided it is cured within 30 days of Your discovery of the violation; or
  - 2. upon express reinstatement by the Licensor.

***For the avoidance of doubt, this Section 6(b) does not limit any right the Licensor may have to seek remedies for Your violations of this Public License.***

- c. For the avoidance of doubt, the Licensor may also offer the Licensed Material under separate terms or conditions or stop distributing the Licensed Material at any time; however, doing so will not terminate this Public License.
- d. Sections 1, 5, 6, 7, and 8 survive termination of this Public License.

#### **Section 7 – Other Terms and Conditions.**

- a. The Licensor shall not be bound by any additional or different terms or conditions communicated by You unless expressly agreed.
- b. Any arrangements, understandings, or agreements regarding the Licensed Material not stated herein are separate from and independent of the terms and conditions of this Public License.

#### **Section 8 – Interpretation.**

- a. **No Restriction on Uses Allowed Without License.** For the avoidance of doubt, this Public License does not, and shall not be interpreted to, reduce, limit, restrict, or impose conditions on any use of the Licensed Material that could lawfully be made without permission under this Public License.

- b. **Headings.** Headings are for informational purposes only and should not be interpreted as affecting the meaning of provisions of this Public License.
- c. **No Limitation on Privileges and Immunities of Licensor.** Nothing in this Public License constitutes or may be interpreted as a limitation upon, or waiver of, any privileges and immunities that apply to the Licensor or You, including from the legal processes of any jurisdiction or authority.
- d. **Reasonable Reliance.** If You exercise the Licensed Rights in compliance with the terms of this Public License, you may reasonably rely on the continued applicability of those Licensed Rights to any furniture you have created through the exercise of those rights, such that the Licensor will not attempt to restrict your exercise of those rights retroactively based on any subsequent amendment to or withdrawal of this Public License.

**Section 9 – Miscellaneous**

- a. **Governing Law.** This Public License shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts without regard to its choice of law provisions and United States federal law, as applicable. The federal and state courts presiding in Boston, Massachusetts shall have exclusive jurisdiction to adjudicate any dispute arising out of this Public License.
- b. **Severability.** If any term, provision, or condition of this Public License or the application thereof to any circumstances is ruled invalid or unenforceable, the validity or enforceability of the remainder of this Public License will not be affected thereby, and each of the other terms, provisions, and conditions of this Public License will be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- c. **No Waiver.** No term or condition of this Public License will be waived and no failure to comply consented to unless expressly agreed to by the Licensor.

**Section 10 – Effective Date & Execution**

- a. **Effective Date.** This Public License shall be effective as of September 26, 2023 and shall remain in effect for each of the works listed in Schedule A and Schedule B until such time as the copyright for said work expires.
- b. I, Arthur Keenan, hereby grant this Public License as the copyright owner of the drawings of Philip C. Lowe identified in Schedule A and Schedule B, by virtue of a Copyright Assignment Agreement, between myself and Sandra Lowe, executed on July 11, 2021, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**.

## COPYRIGHT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

THIS COPYRIGHT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT is made and entered into as of July 8, 2021 by and among Arthur Keenan, of 69 Elm Street, Saugus, Massachusetts, 01906 (“Assignee”) and Sandra Lowe, of 20 Lathrop Street, Beverly, Massachusetts, 01915 (“Assignor”) (collectively, the “Parties”) with reference to the following facts:

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of the copyright to visual works identified in Schedule A;

WHEREAS, Assignor wishes to assign all right, title, and interest in and to the visual works to Assignee in exchange for certain covenants, as set forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, obligations, and conditions set forth below, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound hereby, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1.0 Assignment.** Assignor hereby irrevocably assigns, conveys, or otherwise transfers to Assignee, and Assignee hereby accepts from Assignor, all right, title, and interest throughout the world in and to all furniture designs authored by Philip C. Lowe, including without limitation the visual works identified in Schedule A and all derivatives and iterations thereof, together with the right to recover for damages and profits, and all other remedies for past infringements thereof (collectively, the “Works”) (the “Assignment”).
- 2.0 Notification of Registration.** Within 30 days following the registration of a Work, Assignee shall notify Assignor that the Work has been registered (“Notification”). The Notification shall list the costs associated with digitizing the Work and registering its copyright, as well as any related expenses (collectively, the “Registration Expenses”).
- 3.0 Option to Repurchase.** Assignor shall have the option to repurchase any Work transferred to Assignee pursuant to this Agreement for the purchase price of \$1.00 plus the Registration Expenses (an “Option”). The Assignor may exercise the Option at any time during the one-year period following Notification that a Work has been registered. To exercise an Option, Assignor must communicate in writing her intention to repurchase one or more Works, identifying such Works and must pay the Registration Expenses set forth in the Notification(s) associated with such Work(s) plus a dollar for each such Work.
- 4.0 Consideration.** In exchange for the Assignment, Assignee hereby promises to make a good faith effort to register the copyrights to the Works and to make the Works available to the general public on an unpaid, non-commercial license basis, said license to require any furniture made using the designs set forth in the Works to credit Philip C. Lowe as the creator of the design in a clearly legible font marked upon or inscribed into the furniture in a manner reasonably calculated to last as long as the furniture. For

example, a metal plaque secured to the bottom of a chair stating "Designed by Philip C. Lowe" could be used to satisfy this requirement.

**5.0 Assignor's Representations and Warranties.** Assignor hereby represents and warrants that Assignor is the owner of all the copyrights in the Works and has full power to enter into this Agreement and that this Agreement does not infringe the rights of any third party.

**6.0 Assignor's Covenants.**

6.1 Registration/Recordation. Assignor hereby promises that Assignor shall cooperate with Assignee's efforts (i) to register the Works with any intellectual property office, including without limitation the U.S. Copyright Office, and (ii) to record the Assignment with said offices, such cooperation to include the execution of any documents necessary to effectuate any such registrations or recordations.

6.2 Ownership Defense. Assignor hereby promises that Assignor shall reasonably assist Assignee with respect to any disputes that may arise calling into question Assignor's ownership interests in and to the Works.

**7.0 Assignee's Covenants.** Assignee hereby promises that following the Closing:

7.1 Registration/Recordation. Assignee hereby promises that Assignee shall make a good faith effort to register the copyrights in the Works.

7.2 Availability. Assignee hereby promises that Assignee shall make a good faith effort to make the Works available to the general public on an unpaid non-commercial license basis requiring any furniture made with the Works to credit Philip C. Lowe with the design, as set forth in Section 4.0, above.

**8.0 Miscellaneous.**

8.1 Amendment and Modification. This Agreement may only be amended, modified or supplemented by an agreement in writing signed by each party hereto.

8.2 Entire Agreement. This Agreement supersedes all prior negotiations, understandings, offers and statements of the parties with respect to the matters covered by it. This Agreement is intended to be a final expression of the agreement between the parties regarding the matter covered by it; its terms may not be contradicted by evidence of any prior or contemporaneous agreements. The parties further intend this Agreement to be a complete and exclusive statement of the terms of their agreement regarding the matters covered by it; no extrinsic evidence may be used to interpret, explain or supplement this Agreement.

8.3 Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed in two counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original but both of which together shall constitute one and the

same Agreement. This Agreement shall be enforceable only when the parties have signed it or a counterpart to it.

8.4 Headings. Captions and headings in this Agreement are for convenience only, are not part of this Agreement and shall not be used in construing it.

8.5 Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts without regard to its choice of law provisions and United States federal law, as applicable. The federal and state courts presiding in Boston, Massachusetts shall have exclusive jurisdiction to adjudicate any dispute arising out of this Agreement. The Parties hereby irrevocably consent to the personal jurisdiction of such courts.

8.6 Severability. If any term, provision, or condition of this Agreement or the application thereof to any circumstances is ruled invalid or unenforceable, the validity or enforceability of the remainder of this Agreement will not be affected thereby, and each of the other terms, provisions, and conditions of this Agreement will be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.
